Diana Sylvestre, MD is an Assistant Clinical Professor in the Department of Medicine at the University of California, at San Francisco. A graduate of Harvard Medical School, she received postgraduate medical training at Harvard's Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston and at the Sloan Kettering Institute in New York, NY. Dr Sylvestre is the Executive Director and Founder of O.A.S.I.S (Organization to Achieve Solutions in Substance-Abuse), a nonprofit clinic providing medical care to patients with addictive diseases, and is a leading U.S. researcher in the field of hepatitis C.

Jennifer Lai has a Masters in Science (M.Sc.) in pathology from Queen's University in Canada from 1994 and then obtained a Doctorate in Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) from the University of the Pacific in 1998. She completed Pharmacy Practice Residency at the University of California, San Diego in 1999 and currently practices as a clinical pharmacist in the HIV and HCV clinics in the Departments of Infectious Diseases and Gastroenterology at Kaiser Permanente San Rafael Medical Center. She is a study coordinator for HIV clinical trials and expanded access programs and co-investigator on the Hepatitis C Study Group, Kaiser Permanente Northern California (responsible for starting CHC Registry, analyzing treatment experiences, analyzing clinical practice experiences. She has newly joined the Marin Hepatitis C Task Force.

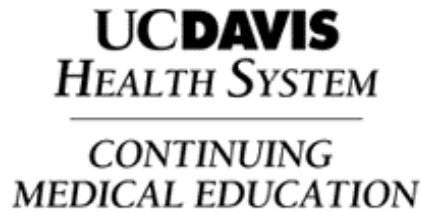
